
All posters must be presented in-person at the Georgia World Congress Center, Atlanta, Georgia, USA.




#### What Goes Up, Must Come Down



### Poster Presenter Responsibilities



#### • Poster presenters are expected to:

- Register for ISPOR 2024 by April 19
- (highly recommended) Upload a digital version of your poster for the conference app by April 29
- (optional) Upload Supplemental materials (handouts, resources) to be featured in the conference app by April 29
- Print and bring your poster to Atlanta, Georgia
  - Please do not ship your poster to the GWCC
  - For your convenience, ISPOR has secured special rates with Scientific Poster Printing, information on that later in the presentation.
- Setup your poster at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the poster session
  - Poster presenters are required to wear your name badge and poster presenter ribbon for poster area access
  - ISPOR will provide poster board number assignments and adhesives to help attach your poster to the board
- Arrive at your poster at least 15 minutes prior to the start of your discussion time
- Remove your poster at the end of your poster session
  - Any posters that are not removed are not the responsibility of ISPOR nor the GWCC and will be discarded

#### **Formatting Guidelines**

Download the Poster Guide for detailed formatting tips (available on ISPOR's <u>Poster Resources</u> page):

- Please note, aside from the horizontal and size format, these guidelines are meant to be helpful tips, not requirements.
- Ultimately, we want to ensure your poster is easy to read/understandable for our attendees.






#### **Poster Layout and Specifications**

- Presenters must prepare a poster sized 3ft x 4ft (36in x 48in)
- The poster board is HORIZONTAL|LANDSCAPE 4ft. (H) x 8ft. (L)
  - Materials must be easily read at a distance of 3ft.
  - As a rule of thumb, use a font size of 16 point to 32 point and double space.
- QR Codes are welcome as long as they are not commercial in nature.
  - ISPOR will no longer provide QR codes at your poster board
- Add your ISPOR-provided acceptance code to the top right-hand corner of your poster (example, EPH1)

#### NOTE: ISPOR will provide push pins.

Prior to the Conference, a poster board assignment (number) will be sent via email to poster presenters. ISPOR will print and display this number for authors.






What's the

Difference

Between

Codes?



Poster Board numbers are assigned and printed by ISPOR. This four-digit number indicates where you should hang your poster during your session.

Presenters will receive their assigned poster board numbers approx. 2 weeks before the conference.

Acceptance codes are assigned by ISPOR in your acceptance notification emails. These are alpha-numeric codes. Presenters are **required** to print their acceptance code on the top right corner of their poster.

This helps attendees find your poster in the ISPOR 2024 mobile app.



#### **Printing & Shipping Your Poster**

The presenter must organize any special shipping arrangements needed on their own. ISPOR will be unable to ship or store any material. **DO NOT SHIP YOUR POSTER TO THE CONVENTION CENTER.** Please note: ISPOR is not responsible for any lost or misplaced posters shipped to the venue.

For your convenience, ISPOR has secured special rates with Scientific Poster Printing.

#### **Scientific Poster Printing**

Scientific Poster Printing has created a specific link with rates for our ISPOR 2024 presenters. With Scientific Poster Printing, you can either:

1. have your poster shipped directly to you (US addresses only), or

2. you can choose the "convention center" option where you will be able to pick up your poster onsite Sunday through Tuesday.

#### Poster sent to Printer Deadline: April 22, 2024

*Note:* This is not a local printer, so there is not an option for pickup at the print shop.

Poster payment and pickup/delivery arrangements are the responsibility of the presenter. This vendor is not an official ISPOR partner, and ISPOR is not responsible for any lost, misplaced, and/or damaged posters. Due to the high volume of onsite poster printing requests, we strongly advise presenters to adhere to the printer deadlines as noted above.






