### **OBJECTIVES** REHABILITATION Improve health and recover quality of life INPATIENT REHAB Hospital-like facilities · Ambulatory care Patients are not at home and cannot go to work Has been default in the past can go to work More flexible and cost-Should be default if efficient medical reasons require Less common in Austria inpatient care Should become default for patients are not covered Not effective for catchment by an ambulatory rehab areas with small populations Increasing demand for rehab Progressive transition from inpatient to ambulatory rehab Demand vs. capacity Location of new ambulatory facilities
